"We need to find out who did all of this," exclaimed Athena.

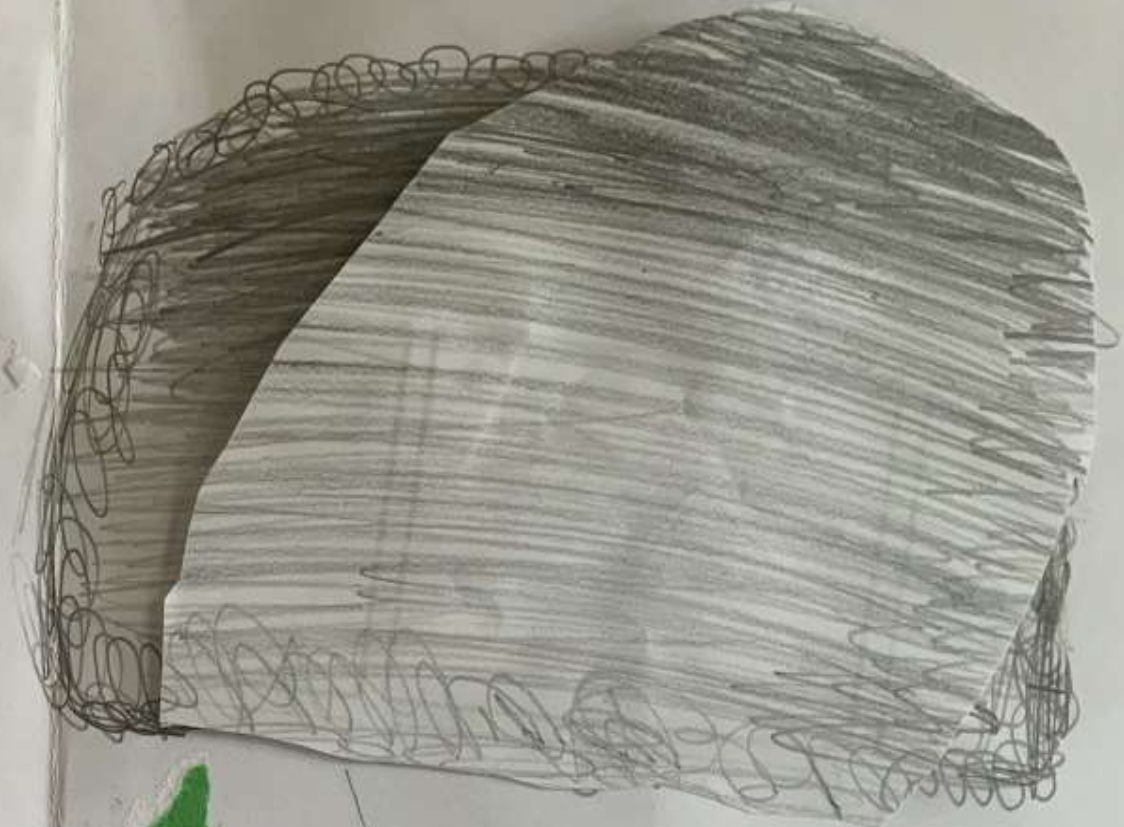
"Currently, there are about 50-75 pieces of plastic in the ocean," said Omar.

requested Omar.

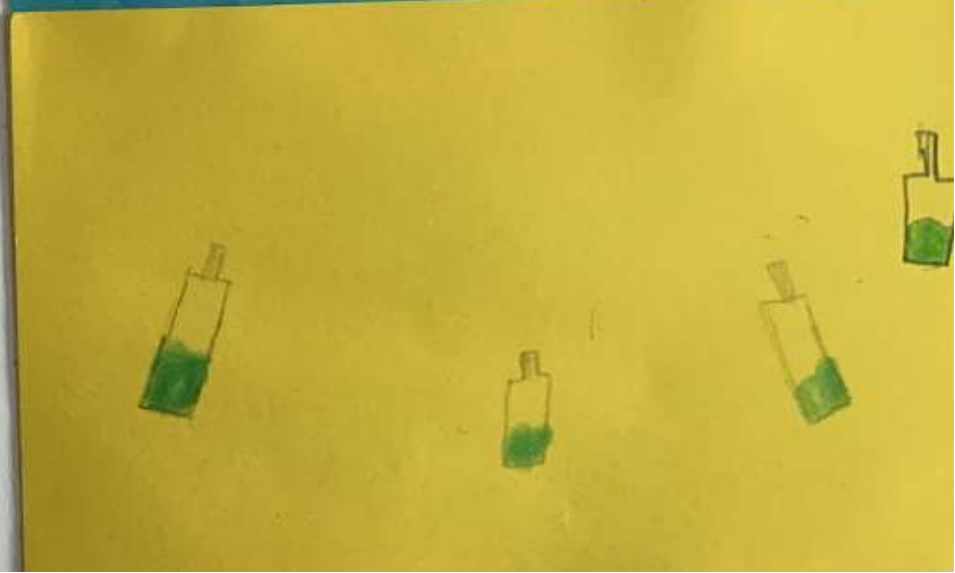
Did you know?

Plastic generally takes between 500-1000 years to degrade. Even then, it becomes microplastic, without fully degrading.

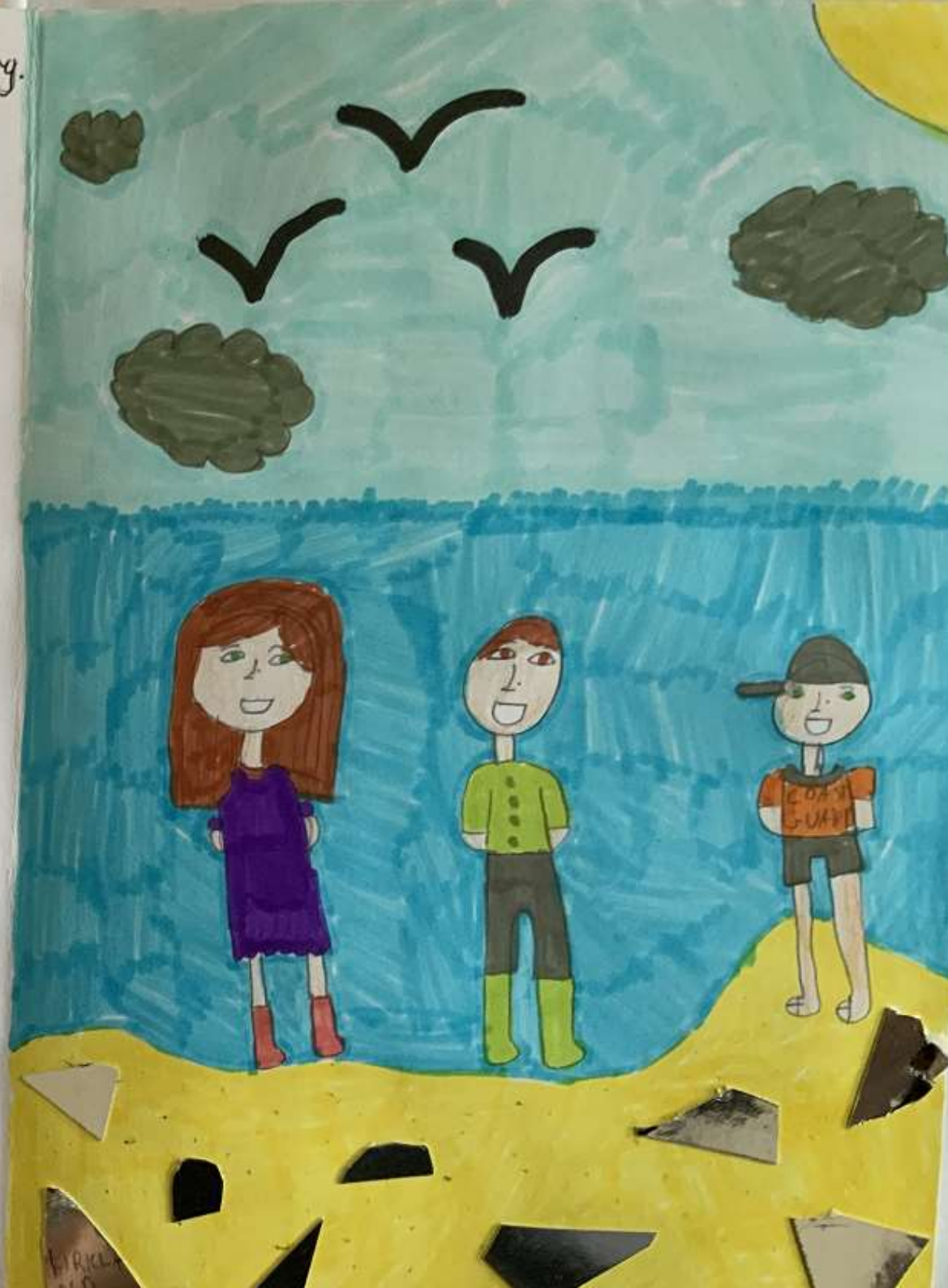


The detectives begin their journey to solve this mystery.

Guard.


"Who might it be?" asked Athena.

"Do not worry BRG!" Said Athena.

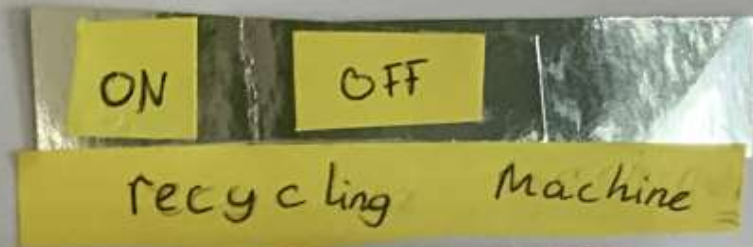
"But how are we going to fix this?" questioned BRG.

"Sure." replied Omar.

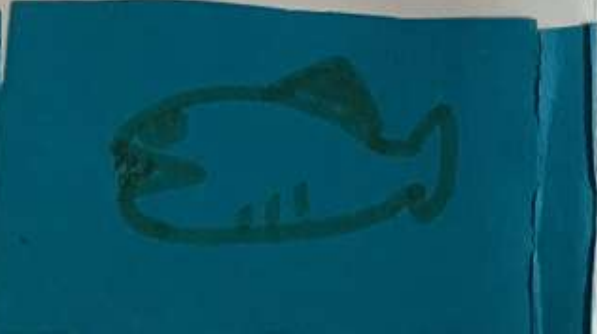
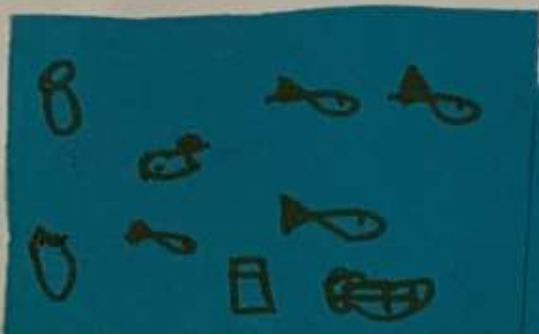
