to the fair, Bear!

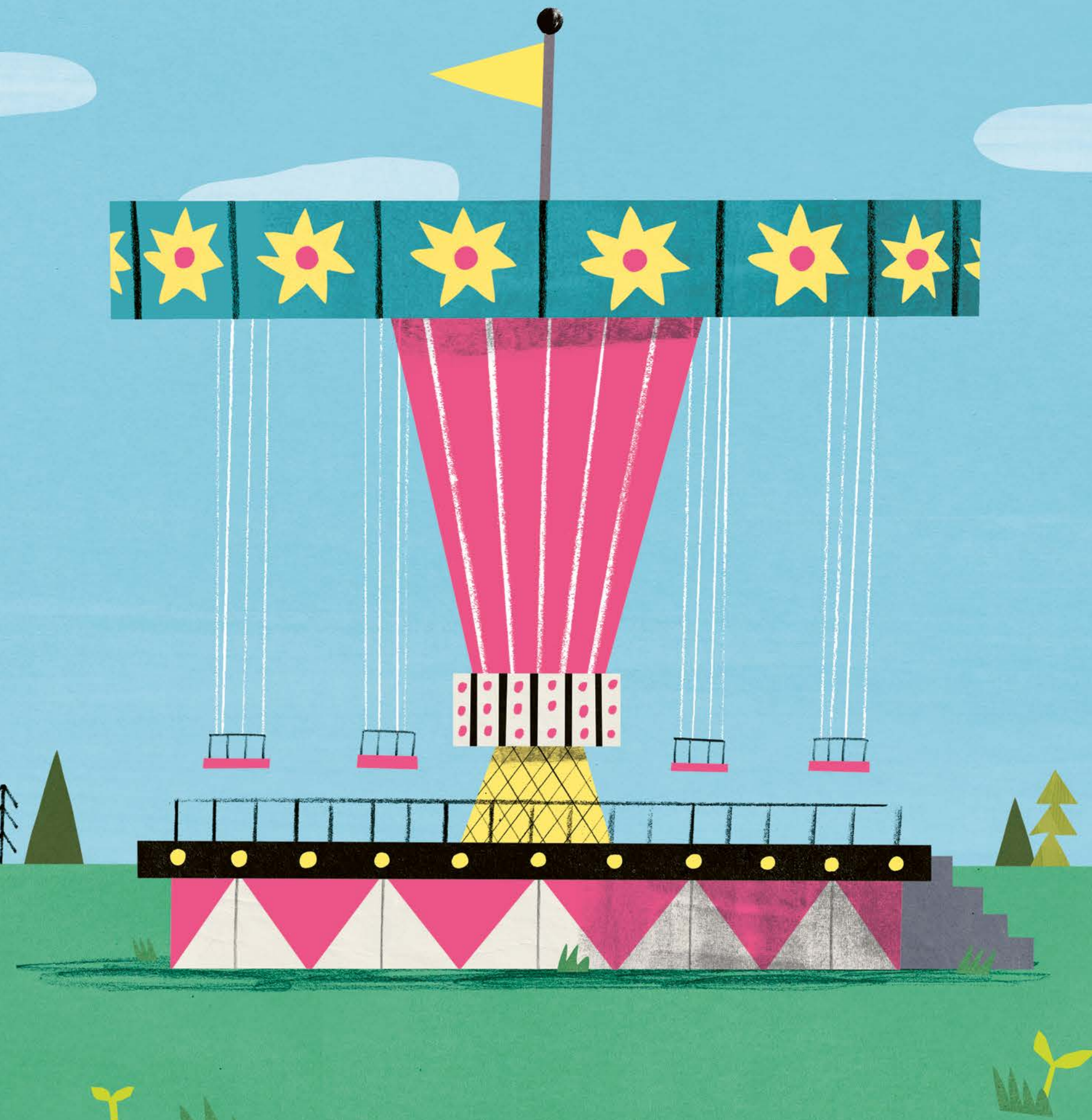




And this is the bear and the hare

on there, Bear?

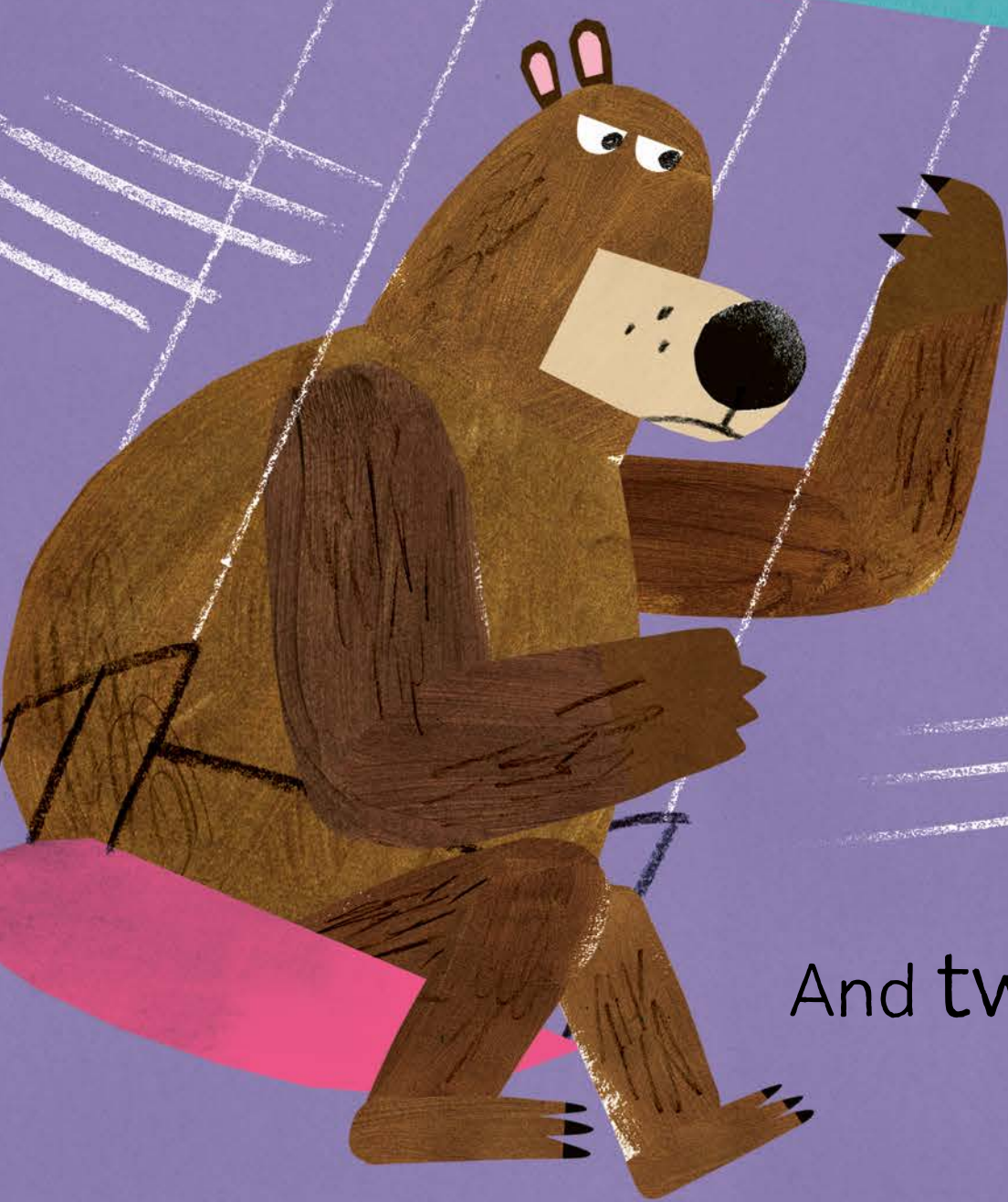
