Is a tree a living thing?



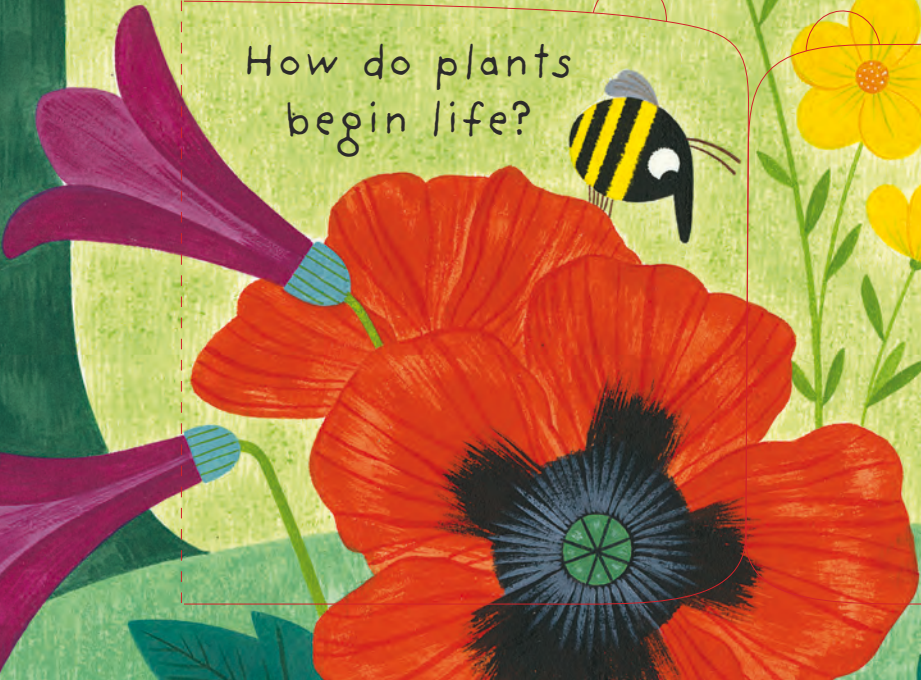
Will my teddy die?
