“I’ve brought some cheesy things with me!”

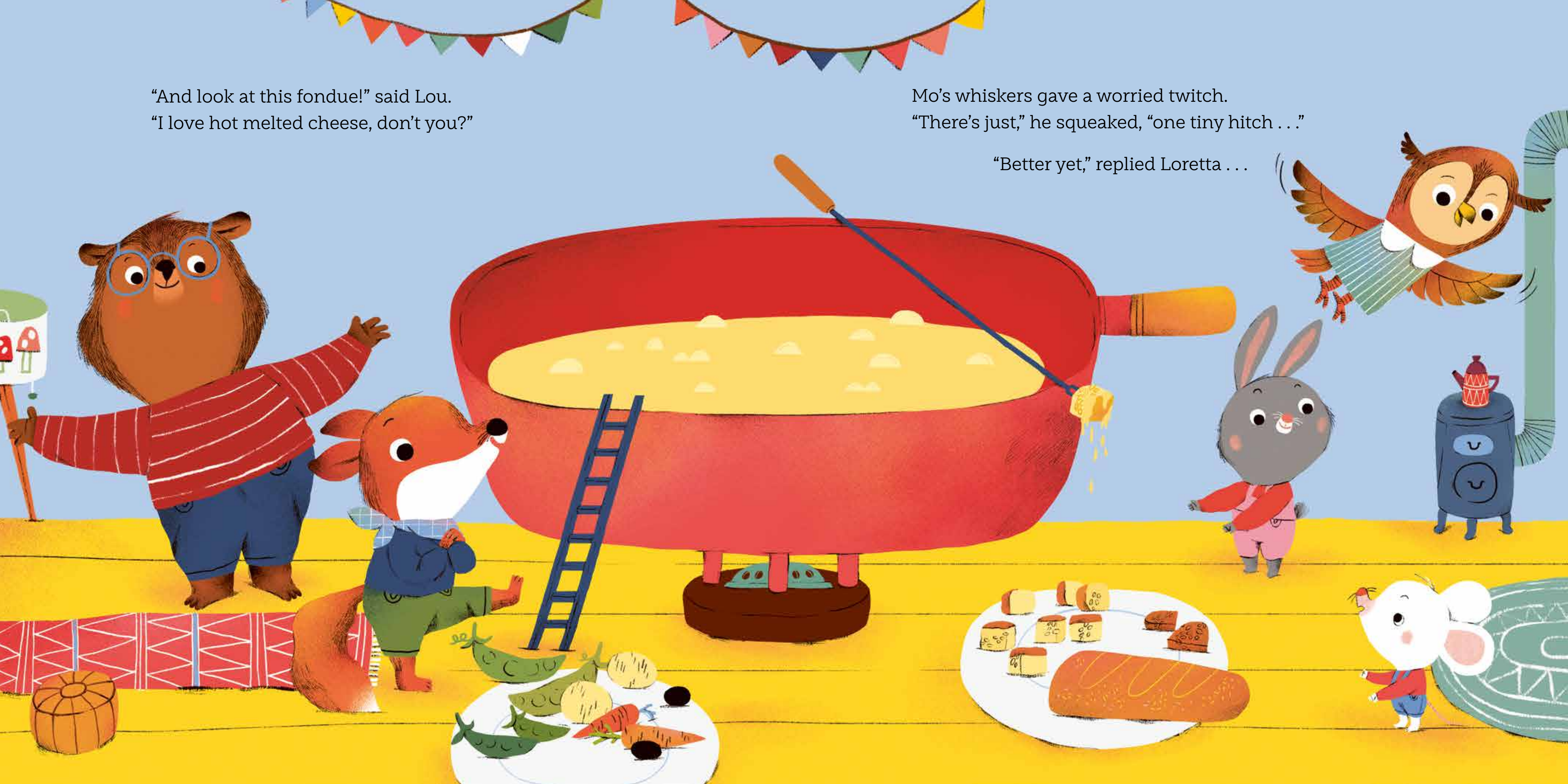



“So have I – TA-DA!” cried Skye.
