Let's Talk

Encourages discussion and vocabulary building through spoken language. Activities include picture/word matching, sounding out Common Exception Words, speech rhythm activities and identifying key words and letter sounds.



Let's Read

Children take their first steps to becoming independent readers. Activities include picture/word matching, identifying key vocabulary words and Common Exception Words, using words in sentences of their own and practising simple retrieval skills.



Let's Listen

readers to use simple skimming and scanning techniques and answer questions. Activities will help children to understand words in context, sequence information, come up with their own descriptions and explanations, and develop key speaking and listening skills.



Let's Write

broaden their vocabulary and practise inferential and prediction skills – as well as opportunities to write their own captions, descriptions and responses based on the text.
